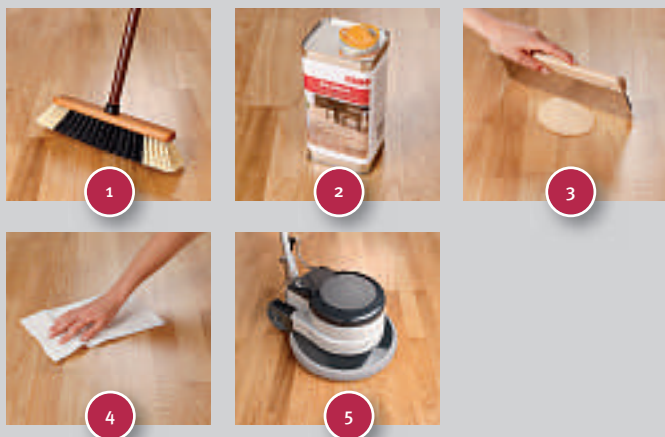

The PERMADUR® Finish is the result of long years of research in our own in-house laboratories in cooperation with technological institutes.

The natural flooring surface is particularly durable and easy to maintain.

Initial care



For areas subject to spillage or wet foot traffic, it is recommended that your newly installed HARO Cork Floor with PERMADUR® Finish be treated with HARO Secura-A immediately after laying. HARO Secura-A significantly reduces the absorption of water during damp mopping and protects the seams and surface against moisture, thus preventing the board edges from swelling.

It's that easy:

First remove dust and dirt from the floor. Do not wipe with a damp cloth – the floor must be completely dry before treatment (1). Apply HARO Secura-A (2) with a double-bladed spatula as thin as possible on approx. 3 m²/3.5 sqft sections (3). Immediately after application, buff the treated surface with a HARO Polishing Cloth (4) or a suitable floor-care machine (5). Place a HARO Polishing Cloth under the pad! Buffing must be completed before the product starts to dry. Do not walk on buffed areas. Repeat the above procedure one section at a time until you have finished the entire floor surface.

It is essential to buff HARO Secura-A until the floor surface is clear without streaks.

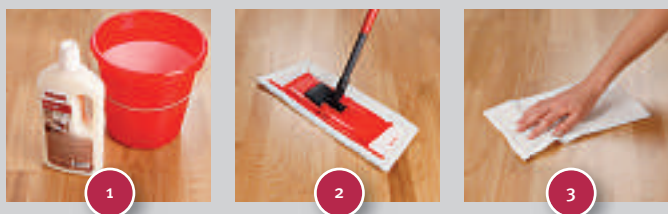
Do not walk on the treated surface for approximately 8 hours.

Soak used cloths in water, hang up outdoors or dispose of in a fire safe way in accordance with local regulations.

Tip:

To ensure a long lifetime of your floor, we recommend – in addition to the initial treatment – routine treatment with HARO Secura-A once a year for intensive care.

Basic care



We recommend basic care of your HARO floor regularly with HARO Polish according to how dirty the floor is and wear and tear. HARO Polish is a solvent-free cleaner for regular cleaning and care of your floor.

It's that easy:

Add approx. 200 ml/6.7 fl.oz. (use the 15 ml/0.5 fl.oz. mark in the cap!) of HARO Polish to 8 – 10 litres/2 – 2.5 gal of cold water (1). Wipe the surface damp with a well wrung-out cloth (2). Do not clean the floor surface too damp. Always avoid letting water stand on the surface. It is not necessary to buff the surface again, but you can do this as required with a HARO Polishing Cloth if you want to increase the sheen of your floor surface. (3).

Tip:

Dry cleaning
Dry cleaning HARO floors with PERMADUR® Finish with a mop, soft broom or vacuum cleaner is child's play.

For regular damp cleaning, we recommend the „Ultramat” floor cleaner set from Vileda.

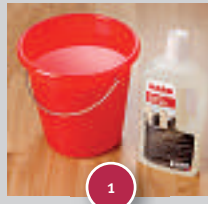

Intensive care

To avoid heavy dirt build-up on your floor, we strongly recommend regular intensive cleaning with HARO Basic Cleaner. HARO Basic Cleaner is a powerful, solvent-free cleaner for intensive cleaning and for the fast and gentle removal of polish residue or ingrained dirt.



It's that simple:

Add about 250 ml/8.5 fl.oz. of HARO Basic Cleaner to 10 litres/2.5 gal of water (1). Apply the solution to the floor surface with a well wrung-out cloth. Do not clean the floor too damp. Always avoid letting water stand on the surface. Leave for about 5 - 10 minutes, then wipe the surface thoroughly with a cloth that has been well wrung out in clear water. Treat the floor with HARO Polish after each intensive cleaning.
